(Please note that the Napoleonic room may be closed without notice in case of official reception. The admission fees will not be paid back but you will visit another museum for free)

**3 « AJACCIO : AN IMPERIAL CITY, A CITY OF ART »**

**Duration 2 hours Departure : appointment in front of the Tourist Office**

The museum occupies the main part of **the Palais Fesch**. It houses an outstanding collection of paintings, some of which were realised by Botticelli, Veronese and Titian. Fesch Museum is also famous of its collection of Italian « primitives » (14<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup> centuries), the most important in France just after the Louvre's. Discovery of this extraordinary heritage left to Ajaccio city by Napoleon's uncle : Cardinal Fesch. Visit of the napoleonic department of the Fesch Museum : unique exhibits.

**Closed Monday ( from 09/01 to 06/30) and Sunday (from 10/01 to 03/31)**
